

Report in Gwank radio Sweden on February 10, 2011

Baloch Student Organization (Azad)'s Central Committee member Qayum Baloch has been tortured and killed by Pakistani security forces. Qayum Baloch was abducted on December 11 by Pakistan army from his house in Gwader and kept in illegal detention by the Pakistan army for 61 days.

His whereabouts were not known to any one and during this time he was severely tortured. Qayyum Baloch's tortured body was thrown in Heronk, Turbat.

Qayyum Baloch, a Central Committee member of B.S.O. (Azad), was associated with B.S.O. for more than eight years, joining the organization in an early age. He was a main figure of the pro-independence politics in Gwader, where his main contribution was foiling the attempts of occupying Pakistan forces and its main ally China to organize a mass migration in the port city which was Qayyum Baloch's hometown. His struggle caused Pakistan to lose its major investments earning him the wrath of the Pakistani military and intelligence services.

Qayyum Baloch was also an active social worker and an advocate of human rights, a friend to almost every resident in his home city of Gwader. Protests are being held throughout Balochistan against this murder.

Apart from this murder, another body was found in Heronk, which was identified as Jameel Yaqoob Baloch, an activist of the Balochistan National Party, who was abducted by Pakistani Frontier Corps and Military Intelligence on August 28, 2010, from Turbat. Jameel Yaqoob was a labor, working on wages to help his family. His body bore severe torture marks just like that of Qayyum Baloch.
