On Sunday June 13, 2010, at 2 PM, the human rights volunteer group Responsible for Equality And Liberty (R.E.A.L.) invites you to a Public Event to remember the tragic June 10, 2009 attack on the U.S. Holocaust Memorial Museum and the murder of Stephen Tyrone Johns. The public event will be held at Freedom Plaza in Washington DC in front of the National Theater at 1321 Pennsylvania Avenue, NW, Washington, DC 20004, between 13th and 14th Streets, NW, which is a few blocks away from Metro Center.

We will have public prayer and testimony by those who will defy such hate, and choose to support our fellow Americans' equality and liberty. While we urge each other to be vigilant against the white supremacist and anti-semitic hate responsible for such crimes, we will also urge those who hate to drop the burden of hate from their hearts, and say "Never Again" to Hate - Choose Love, Not Hate.



Our Public Event at DC's Freedom Plaza is near where Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. worked on his speech "I Have a Dream." We will stand united in our diverse religions, ethnicity, and races in respect and love for our fellow human beings, remembering the tragedy of June 10, 2009, and committed to the dream of equality and liberty for all. We don't answer hate with hate. Instead of an upraised fist, we offer outstretched hands and hearts to those who do hate, to urge them to release the burden of hate from their hearts, and join us in defending the human rights and dignity of all people.

Walking Directions - Metro Center Metro Station to Pennsylvania Ave NW & 14th St NW:
